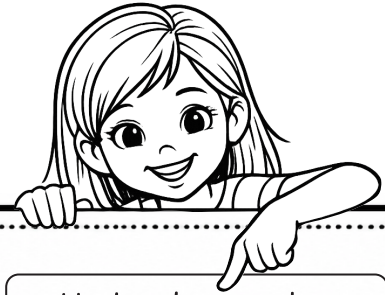


An idiom is a type of figurative language where the words together have a special meaning that is different from their literal meaning.
