# Suffix Origins 'ise' or 'ize' ?

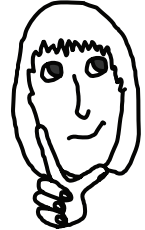


The spelling you use depends on where you live

The suffix "ise" or "ize" can be added to a word to create a verb.  
The British preferred spelling in "ise" and the American preferred spelling is "ize".

The suffix has roots in Latin "izare" and Greek "izen" but it is the Old French "iser" that has been carried through to British English.
