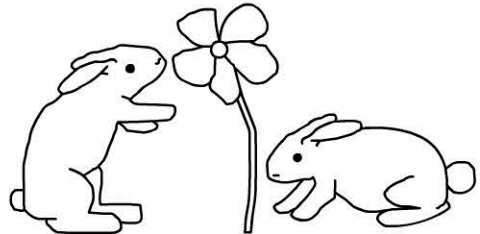

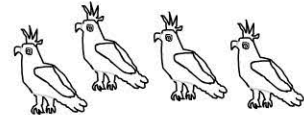

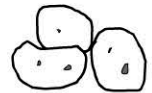


- 2) There are 82 adults in our football association. Half are women. How many are men? _____
