Commas with Adjectives and Adverbs

Commas are used when we have two or more adjectives modifying a noun, or two or more adverbs modifying a verb.

Examples:

Anna is a smart, happy, cheerful student. In this sentence the adjectives smart, happy and cheerful modify the noun 'student'.

Andrew quietly, slowly, carefully moved towards the cave's entrance.

In this sentence quietly, slowly and carefully modify the verb 'moved'.
