

# Commas with Adjectives and Adverbs

Commas are used when we have two or more adjectives modifying a noun, or two or more adverbs modifying a verb.

Examples:

Anna is a **smart, happy, cheerful** student.

*In this sentence the adjectives smart, happy and cheerful modify the noun 'student'.*

Andrew **quietly, slowly, carefully** moved towards the cave's entrance.

*In this sentence quietly, slowly and carefully modify the verb 'moved'.*
