Write your own story where the color red is important.

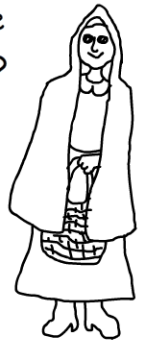

Where does the story take place?

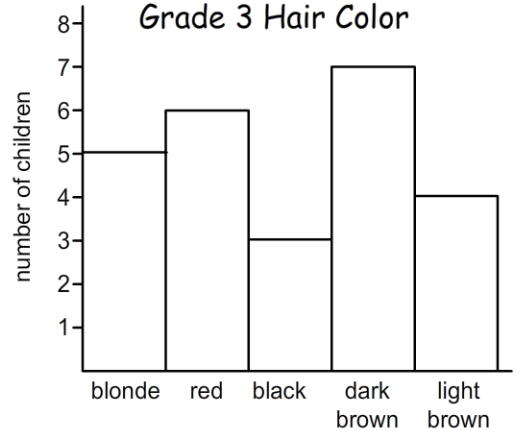
What happens? (The sequence of events)
