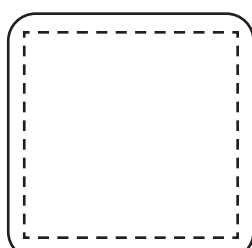
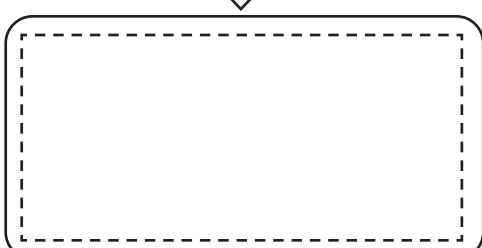
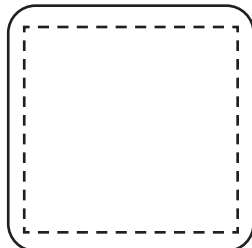
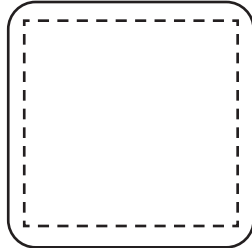
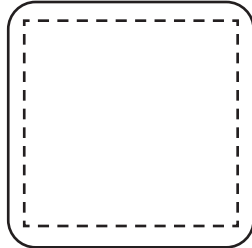
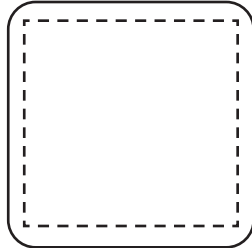
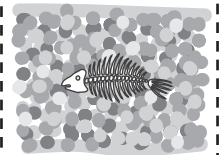
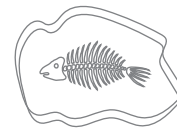
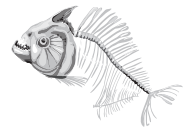


## Sequencing Events in the Fossilization Process
