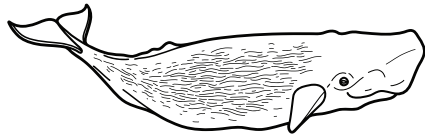
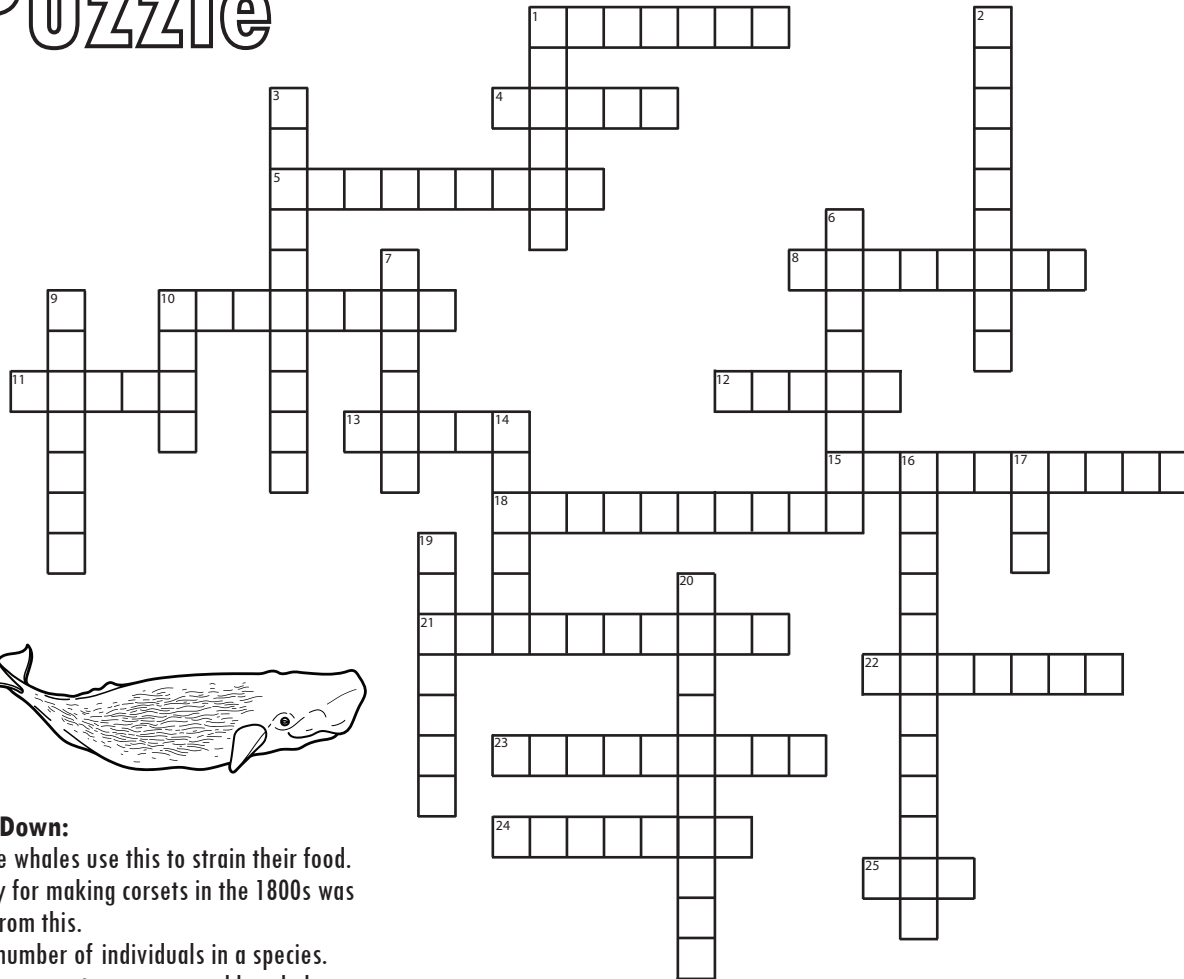


Crossword Puzzle
