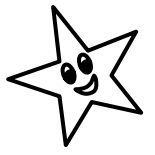




Prefix Origins "bi-"

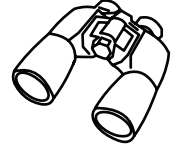


Adding the prefix "bi-" to a word applies the meaning "two", "twice", "double" or "once every two". This prefix has its origins in Latin.



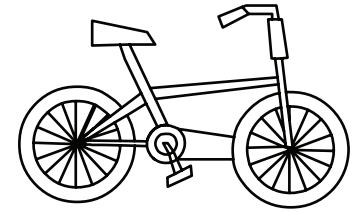
