A bossy silent "e" at the end of a word makes the vowel say its name, which means the vowel sound will be long.

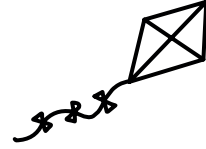
example:

kite



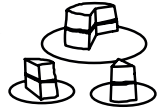
has a long "i" vowel sound

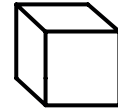
