








Petroleum oil can be found between rock layers deep under the ground. Sometimes it can be found in rock layers under the sea.

Petroleum oil can be reached by drilling deep down through the layers of the Earth. Oil is brought to the surface by pumping. The crude oil is then sent to a refinery.

In some parts of the world oil is sent through an overland pipeline. It can also be transported by truck and by ship.
