\* ate - eight

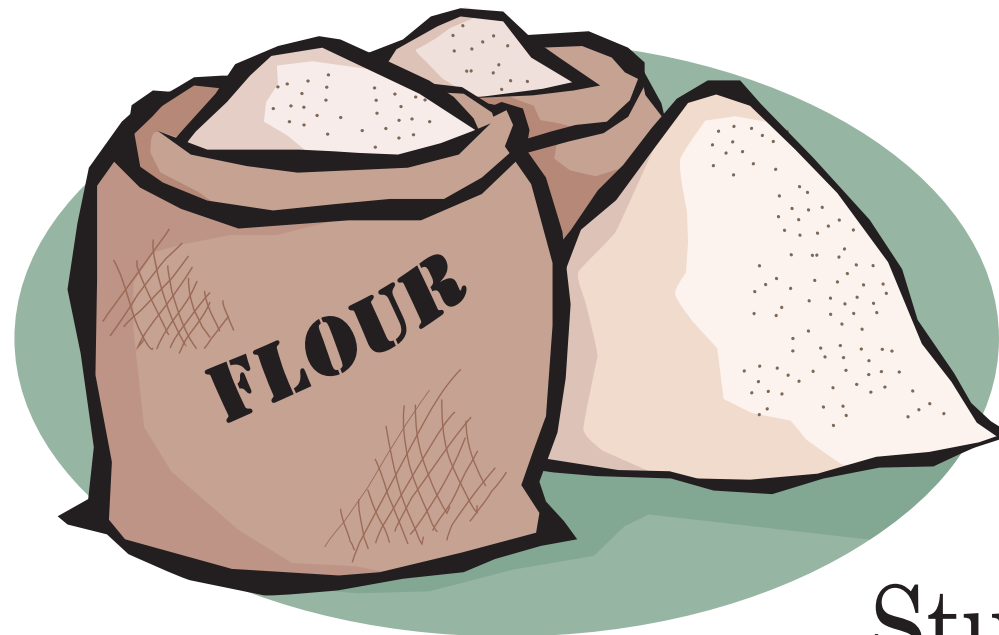
\* knot - not
