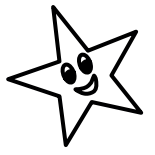


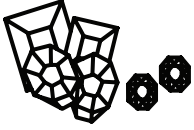


The letter 'g' can make a soft sound Rule

sound soft

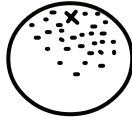

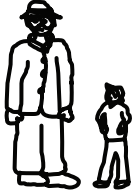
