
Relating Verbs

Relating verbs do not show action, instead they connect the, 'subject', to the part of the sentence that follows the verb.

Relating verbs help identify or describe some characteristic of a person or thing.

For example: I have big feet.

Relating verbs are about being.

To be: am, is, are, was, were, be, being, been

For example:

We were in the rain.

or having.

To have: have, has, had

For example:

Harry had a good time.

Jim has two sisters.

Kangaroos and wombats are mammals.

Charlotte became class captain.
