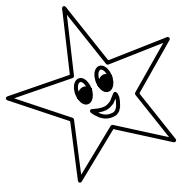




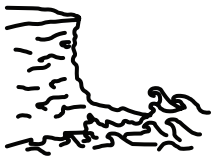
Spelling Rules



Double letters at the end of a word:

A double "f" "l" "s" or "z" is often used after a short vowel at the end of a one syllable word.

examples:



cliff

"ff" after short "i"



mess

"ss" after short "e"

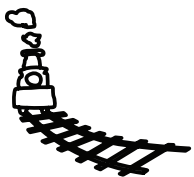
These words end in double letters after a short vowel sound:
