• Silver is a precious metal. It has been used for coinage, jewellery, tableware, dental alloys, and photography.




- In ancient Egypt and mediaeval Europe silver was often more valuable than gold.

- Silver is very malleable. One grain of silver can be made into a sheet one hundred and fifty times thinner than a piece of paper.


